

PRESCRIPTION HELP:

Prescription Assistance Programs help people find their prescription medications at a reduced cost. This includes programs that may be offered by brand-name drug manufactures. The assistance includes a mailing of Pharmacy Assistance forms that match the drugs used by the individual, plus a toll-free call center to help individuals complete their packets to gain access to these programs. Partnership for Prescription Assistance

Assists those who lack medical coverage with getting FREE or nearly free drugs (more than 1200 medications available). Access to more than 275 public and private patient assistance programs including more than 150 programs offered by pharmaceutical companies. Together Rx Access Card

Offers discounts of 25-40% on 275 brand-name prescription drugs and a wide variety of generic drugs. It is available for people who have no prescription coverage and who are not eligible for Medicare or any Medicaid program. Must have an income of:

\$30,000 or less for an individual, \$40,000 or less for couples, \$50,000 or less for a family of three, \$60,000 or less for a family of four, and \$70,000 or less for a family of five

DRUG MANUFACTURERS:

Eligibility: 1) Must have no other prescription drug coverage, and 2) individual annual income below \$18,000 or household income below \$24,000.
